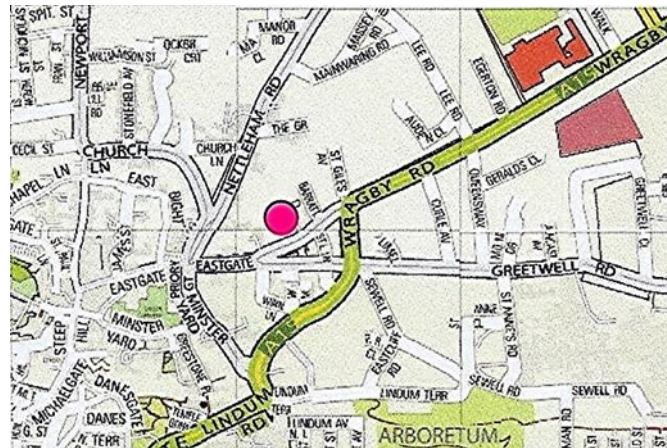

PLAYING OPPORTUNITIES

REGULAR ROLL-UPS

These take place on Tuesday and Thursday Afternoons commencing at 14.15hr but players are asked to be present at the Green by 14.00hr for setting up. There are also Roll-ups on Friday evenings at 18.15hr but players are asked to be present at the Green by 18.00hr for setting up.

INFORMAL ROLL-UPS

Any time after 10.30 a.m. by personal arrangement, provided that the Groundsman is not working on the Green (he normally cuts the green on Monday, Wednesday and Friday mornings, and waters when necessary).

COACHING

Available by arrangement with the Club Coach. He normally attends on Friday evenings from about 18.15 p.m.

LEAGUES

Eastgate Bowls Club has entered teams in the following local leagues: City Evening, District, Cliff and City Afternoon. The respective Captains are Judy Payne, John Dean, Dilys Baker, and Alfred Schneider. A match fee of £1 per match is payable by every player. Availability for selection is to be shown by writing your name on the match sheets in the Clubhouse, or (if specified by the Team Captain) by email.

Ladies Wednesday League

1. The aim of the Wednesday morning League is to provide an opportunity for ladies to compete in a league environment.
2. A league environment that has the emphasis on enjoyment, the rules below intended to act as guidance.
3. Teams to contain a maximum of seven players playing triples with three bowls.
4. Matches to be played Wednesday morning, arriving no later than 09:45 for start 10:00.
5. Matches to be 18 ends, with no trial ends
6. Match venue—different clubs as available.
7. Match dress—grey skirt or trousers, white top, suitable bowls footwear, if sandals are worn it is at the players own risk of injury.
8. If play has to be stopped at less than 12 ends the game is void, If play is stopped at 12 ends or more the score will be taken at twelve ends and shall count as the game played. Note all teams must complete at least 12 ends.
9. Players not playing may play for any team in order to keep the league going.
10. Green fees—all green fees and registration fees are to be set annually. All green fees to be paid by team captains. Fees must be paid by any team failing to fulfil any fixture.
11. Prizes—to be agreed annually. Prize presentation will follow last match.
12. All matches played under EBA rules. Touchers chalked and all in at any distance.

LADIES' COMPETITIONS

There are County knock-out competitions under both EBA & EBF codes, working toward County and National Championships, latter held in August at Leamington Spa and Skegness respectively.

The Ladies have entered County EBA competitions with Pairs, Triples and Rink entries.
