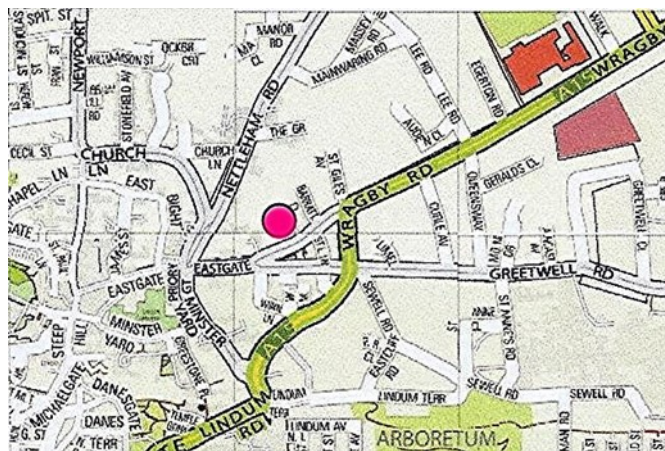

PLAYING OPPORTUNITIES

REGULAR ROLL-UPS

Roll-ups take place on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons commencing at 14.15hr. Players are asked to be present at the Green by 14.00hr for setting up. There are also Roll-ups on Friday evenings at 18.15hr. Players are asked to be present at the Green by 18.00hr for setting up.

INFORMAL ROLL-UPS

After 10.30 a.m. by personal arrangement, provided that the Groundsman is not working on the Green (he normally cuts the green on Monday, Wednesday and Friday mornings, but waters when necessary).

COACHING

Available by arrangement with the Club Coach. He normally attends on Friday evenings from about 18.15 p.m.

LEAGUES

Eastgate Bowls Club has entered teams in the following local leagues: City Evening, District, Cliff and City Afternoon. The respective Captains are Chris Butler, John Dean, Dilys Baker, and Alfred Schneider. A match fee of £1 per match is payable by every player. Availability for selection is to be shown by writing your name on the match sheets in the Clubhouse, or

LEAGUE TEAM SELECTION

1. The Committee has delegated total authority to the elected Captains of the four League Teams to select players from those entered to play. Members are asked to recognise that the Captains often have a difficult task in matching Members' playing preferences (e.g. as Lead, Number 2 or Skip) with the need to maximise the potential to win.
2. The Committee has asked the Captains to have regard to the following guidelines *wherever possible*:
 - a. team captains will not normally select teams more than 10 days before a match to allow members time to put themselves forward for selection.
 - b. the City Afternoon Team should be selected on the basis that the newer and less experienced bowlers, and Members who want to play only in the afternoon, will have preference.
3. The Committee believe that among the Membership which wishes to play in League matches it should normally be possible to meet Members' desire to play on at least 7 out of 10 occasions when they have entered their name on the selection sheets.
4. The Committee asks Members who wish to play in League Teams:
 - a. not to express any desire to play or not to play with specified other Members either in a Team or on a Rink;
 - b. in the case of married or partnership couples to be prepared to play in a match without their spouse/partner, although Team Captains will try to select couples together when possible;
 - c. not to specify their preferred position on a rink (i.e. as Lead, Number 2 or Skip), although Team Captains will do their best to meet informally expressed preferences.

5. In the event that a member feels that he or she is being treated unfairly, the member should raise the matter informally with the Chairman who will do his best to resolve the issue, but with the option of referring the matter to the Committee if the Chairman feels it would be helpful to do so, or if so requested by the member concerned.

Players are personally responsible for checking if they have been picked and their arrangements for getting to the match.
